In 2020, the median income for Virginia's LCPs was \$90k-\$100k.

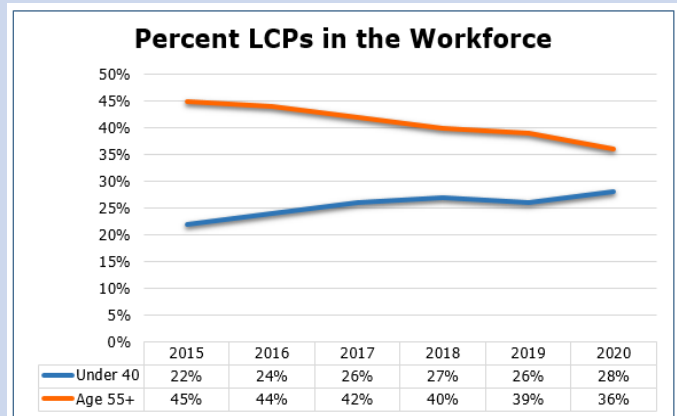

## Licensed Clinical Psychologist

In 2020, there were 3,887 **Licensed Clinical Psychologists** (LCPs) in Virginia. Of that number, 2,860 were in the workforce and produced FTEs. This workforce was 69% female, with 86% of them under the age of 40. Ninety-four percent of the workforce were employed, with 58% holding one full-time job. 96% of LCPs reported being satisfied with their current employment situation.

\*Of the LCPs licensed in 2020, 415 temporary licenses were issued between April and June pursuant to an Executive Order that was implemented by the DHP due to the COVID19 pandemic. All of these temporary licenses expired September 8, 2020, and were excluded from the total licensure count.



More than 70% of LCPs work in the private sector, including 58% who work at for-profit establishments.

Four out of every five LCPs in the state work in Northern Virginia, Central Virginia and Hampton Roads.

Sixty-three percent of all LCPs treat between one and 24 patients per week at their primary locations.

Nearly one-quarter of all of LCPs currently have multiple work locations.

## Trends 2015-2020

- The number of licensed LCPs in Virginia has increased by 36%.
- The size of the workforce has increased by 19%.
- The diversity index has increased from 26% to 32%.
- The median age of the states LCP workforce has fallen from 52 to 49.
