

## **Dental Hygienist**

In 2021, there were 6,092 Dental Hygienists in Virginia. Of that number, 5,070 were in the workforce and produced 3,047 FTEs. This workforce was 98% female and the median age of all dental hygienists was 44.

Eighty-eight percent of the workforce was employed, with 56% holding one full-time job. 94% of dental hygienists reported being satisfied with their employment situation.



Ninety-four percent of all dental hygienists work in the for-profit sector, including 71% that work at a solo-practice.

Thirty-three percent of all dental hygienists work in Northern Virginia, 24% in Hampton Roads and 18% in Central Virginia.

Eighty-one percent of all dental hygienists receive an hourly wage at their primary work location.

Fifty-six percent hold one full-time job, and 51% work between 30 and 39 hours per week.

## **Trends 2016-2021**

- The number of licensed dental hygienists in Virginia has increased by 6% from 5,727 in 2016 to 6,092 in 2021.
- The median annual income has increased from \$50k-\$60k to \$60k-\$70k.
- The dental hygienist workforce has become more diverse. The diversity index has risen from 33% in 2016 to 38% in 2021.
